Best Model Award

Objective:

To promote innovative thinking through functional or conceptual models addressing educational, technical, or societal challenges.

Guidelines:

- Open to faculty, researchers, and students
- Models may be physical, working, or conceptual
- The model must demonstrate:
 - Originality and innovation
 - Practical relevance and applicability
 - Technical clarity and presentation quality
- Participants must explain the concept, working principle, and applications
- Duration of presentation: 5–7 minutes

Best Poster Award

Objective:

To provide a platform for presenting research ideas, case studies, or innovations in a visually engaging manner.

Guidelines:

- Posters should cover research work, case studies, best practices, or innovations
- Poster size: A0 (Portrait)
- Content should include:
 - Title, authors, and affiliation
 - Objective, methodology, key findings, and conclusion
- Visual clarity, originality, and relevance will be evaluated



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Best Practices Showcase by Institutions

NEP 2020 Implementation in Schools, Colleges & Universities

Objective

The Best Practices Showcase aims to recognize and disseminate effective, innovative, and scalable institutional practices adopted for the implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 across schools, colleges, and universities.

Eligibility

- Schools, Colleges, Universities, and Higher Education Institutions
- Participation through institutional representatives (Head/Faculty/Coordinator)
- The best practice must be implemented and operational, not merely proposed

Themes (Indicative)

- Curriculum restructuring and multidisciplinary education
- Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) and flexible learning pathways
- Experiential learning, internships, and skill development
- Digital learning and technology integration
- Assessment reforms and competency-based education
- Faculty development and leadership initiatives
- Inclusion, equity, and holistic student development

Guidelines for Best Practices Showcase

- Each institution may submit one or two best practices
- The submission should include:
 - Title of the best practice
 - NEP 2020 component addressed
 - Objective and need of the practice
 - Implementation strategy and timeline
 - Outcomes and measurable impact
 - Innovation, sustainability, and scalability
- Supporting evidence (photographs, reports, links, data) is desirable
- Presentation format: Poster / PPT-based showcase
- Presentation duration: 8–10 minutes

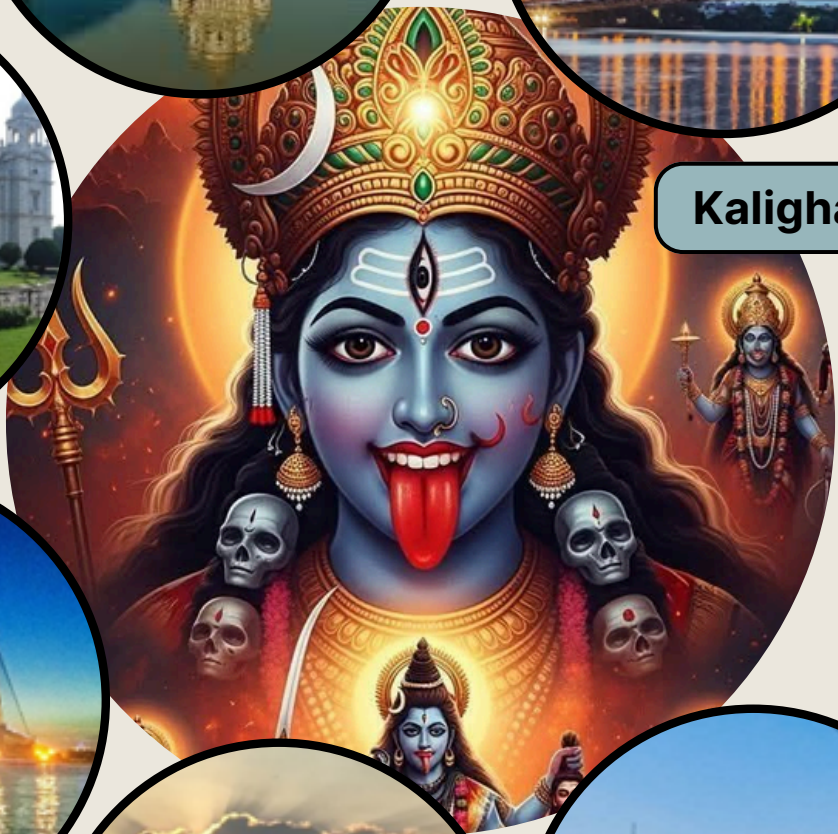

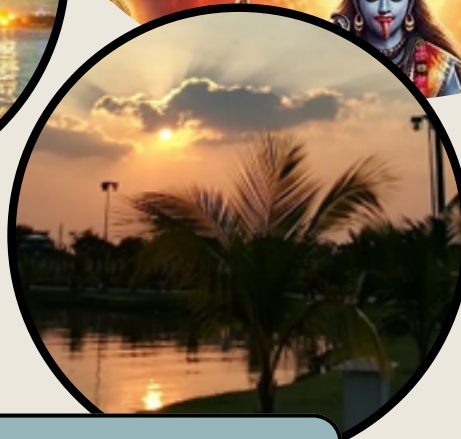
