(NITTTR Kolkata Celebrates 62nd Foundation Day with Grand Academic, Cultural and Alumni Engagement Programmes)

The National Institute of Technical Teachers' Training and Research, Kolkata (NITTTR Kolkata) commenced its year-long celebration of the 62nd Foundation Day on 11 January 2026, marking over six decades of dedicated service towards quality assurance and capacity building in the technical education system of India.

A fully centrally funded institute under the Ministry of Education, Government of India, NITTTR Kolkata has been playing a pivotal role in strengthening both polytechnic and degree-level technical education across the country. The Institute began its journey on **11 January 1965** as the *Technical Teachers' Training Institute (Eastern Region)* and, in recognition of its exemplary contributions, was elevated to National Level Institute. In **2024**, the Institute was conferred **Deemed to be University status under the Distinct Category** by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

The Foundation Day celebration on 11 January 2026 began with the hoisting of the National Flag and the Institute Flag, followed by the National Anthem, symbolizing the Institute's commitment to national service and academic excellence. The inaugural session was held at the **Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Auditorium**, where the ceremonial lighting of the lamp and Saraswati Vandana marked the formal commencement of the event.

The programme was graced by the presence of eminent dignitaries, including the **Hon'ble Chief Guest, Prof. Rajeev Srivastava, Director, IIIT Ranchi, Guest of Honour, Shri Om Prakash Mishra, Executive Director (Community Development) Coal India Limited, Shri Sajjan Bhajanka, Chairman, Board of Governors, NITTTR Kolkata** and along with other distinguished guests, Ex-members of Faculty and Staff, alumni, faculty members, officials, staff, trainees, students, and research scholars.

Addressing the gathering, the **Guest of Honour, Shri Om Prakash Mishra, Executive Director (Community Development), Coal India Limited**, reflects on the journey of Bengal and its cultural roots, connecting it to a decades long journey of growth and identity. Sharing personal experiences, he emphasizes the transformative role of engineers in building infrastructure and improving lives, recounting advice to "convert a desert into heaven." He highlights that technical teachers play an even greater role, acting as lamps of hope who ignite creativity, knowledge, and societal development in young minds. Despite challenges like remote locations and harsh conditions, their work shapes the future of Indian education, promotes sustainability, and ensures progress reaches every corner of the country. The **Hon'ble Chief Guest, Prof. Rajeev Srivastava, Director, IIT Ranchi**, in his keynote address, reflects on the proud legacy and expanded mandate of NITTTR Kolkata, highlighting its critical role in advancing technical education, research, consultancy, skill development, and national capacity building in a rapidly changing digital era. In alignment with NEP 2020, Digital India, and the vision of Vikshit Bharat@2047, the address stresses the urgent need to modernize curricula, adopt flexible learning pathways, and integrate ethics, social responsibility, Indian Knowledge Systems, culture, and sustainability into engineering education. Teachers are called upon to continuously retrain, unlearn, and adapt to new technologies and learner expectations, while motivating students to engage with core engineering, societal challenges, and national development. Emphasis is placed on inclusivity, multilingual learning, industry alignment, self-reliance, and innovation, ensuring that technical education not only produces skilled professionals but also responsible citizens who contribute to social harmony, green growth, and India's long-term global competitiveness.

Initiatives like the three-centre of excellence program demonstrate our potential, but continued effort in training, academics, and industry engagement is crucial to strengthen our institute's profile.

The Dean (Research Planning and Development) addresses everyone on this auspicious day, marking the 62nd year of the institute and its evolution into a Deemed to be University under distinct category. This day celebrates the vision and dedication of the founders, past faculty, and current members who have transformed the institute step by step. As we face a world driven by AI, machine learning, and dynamic technological change, research, innovation, and industry collaboration are critical. With ongoing national projects, skill development programs, and international learning, we aim to strengthen teaching, foster emerging technologies, and contribute globally.
